Storage of the Statue of Mary.—Special meetings and decisions about the Lenten environments and what will be needed for both the Triduum and Easter were addressed and discussed.—The issue of the statue of Mary must still be addressed.

 - A) Roundtable on the ministries we each represent.—Each member was talked to about their concerns or needs by phone, e-mail, and in person in some cases.

- B) Ministers of the Eucharist, new information from the bishop.— Terry began his sacristy meeting w/ all ministers of the Eucharist. This worked well as we engaged them in the duties and service of their ministry. This is an on-going education.
- C) Bilingual missals.—the commission and the Spanish community agree that this should be the way we go when ordering our Missal needs for 2008 Liturgical year.
- D) Altar servers, ideas.—There will be training of a new group of servers in May, prior to the new schedule for June-September. These kids will come from the 4th and 5th grades at St. Isidore School. This way we will not loose the time between the training and the actual altar duties.
- E) L of the W with C, summer needs for the handouts.—Spoke with Ken about the summer needs and then Lisa about the folders for the kids who attend. Also how many leader guides we'll need, so that monies can be saved.
